In Carfin: There will be a Eucharistic week leading up to the Feast of The Body and Blood of Christ (*Corpus Christi*), beginning Monday 13th to Sunday 19th of June. There will be a 10.00 am Mass and 1.00 am Mass each day and a 'Holy Hour' on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday at 7.00 pm. An all-night vigil of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Glass Chapel begins after the 5.00 pm Vigil Mass on Saturday evening and concludes with a Dawn Mass for the Feast of *Corpus Christi* at 7.00 am. A Eucharistic Procession from St Teresa's Church, Newarthill, begins at 3.00 pm on the afternoon of *Corpus Christi* Sunday. Bishop Toal will preside at Benediction in the grotto around 3.30 – 4.00 pm.
