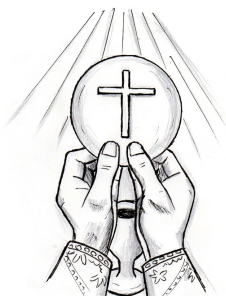

Today (Sunday) we begin 40 hours celebration in St Thomas' church. It is a special time of appreciation of the gift of the Eucharist among us and a moment to rediscover our faith. 7.00 pm Mass for the Sick - (Fr Kieran Hamilton – St Brandon's) Please ensure that all the sick of our Parishes will be at this Mass. After Mass there will be tea in the Hall. *(If you need assistance with transportation please speak to members of SVDP).*

As a part of the celebration of the World Meeting of Families on Sunday 26th June, we will celebrate Mass for families at 9.30 am (St Patrick's) and 11.00 am (St Thomas'). For the Mass, couples who celebrate 5th, 10th, 20th, 25th, 50th and other round anniversaries are invited to renew their vows. After these Masses, tea and coffee will be served in the halls.

To mark the World Day of Families Bishop Toal will celebrate the Diocesan Mass for Families in the Cathedral on Sunday 26th June at 3pm – each parish is asked to send two families to this Mass. If you wish to take part in this important event please let Father Krzysztof know.

The prayer card for the forthcoming World Meeting of Families due to take place in Rome 22-26 June with the official prayer for families is available to pick from the back of the church. The theme of this year is: *“Family Love: a Vocation and a Path to Holiness.”*

The Pioneer Association - “Mass for the Feast of the Sacred Heart will take place in St Francis Xavier's Church, Carfin on Friday 24th June, commencing at 7.30pm – All are Welcome”. Tea & Coffee will be served in the Hall after Mass.

The Autumn Fayre in St Patrick's will take place on Saturday 10th September. We are looking for new volunteers to distribute Parish letters to possible donors. We hope you can help us in securing donations for the church. If you have some ideas please speak to Father. We are raising funds to resurface the car park at the church grounds.

Deacon Christopher Morris will be ordained to the priesthood by Bishop Toal on Thursday 30th June at 6.30 pm in Our Lady of Good Aid Cathedral, Motherwell. All are welcome to join Christopher at the reception afterwards in St Bride's Hall.

Those adults who consider being christened or being received into the Catholic Church next year at Easter are asked to contact Fr Krzysztof.

A Eucharistic Procession from St Teresa's Church, Newarthill, begins at 3.00 pm on the afternoon of *Corpus Christi* Sunday. Bishop Toal will preside at Benediction in the grotto around 3.30 – 4.00 pm.

St Patrick's and St Thomas' Parish trip will take place on Saturday 13th August. We hope to travel to Lindsfarne as last time we did not reach it due to traffic congestion. As high tide is about 2.00 pm, the second part of the day will be spent in one of the coastal towns. Price to be confirmed. Pray for good weather.

We are piloting a new idea in the church for children – play corner for toddlers! We hope this will help parents when their children become restless at Mass. They can take them to this area where they can play with toys, draw, and colour in books. Parents are asked to stay with their child when using this area and make sure there is still prayerful atmosphere there.
