<u>FIRST HOLY COMMUNION</u> will be celebrated this year on 11 May at 10 am in St Thomas' and at 12 noon in St Patrick's. Please pray for these children as they prepare for this most important Sacrament.

<u>CLERGY APPOINTMENTS</u>: As from the weekend of 8/9 June there will be a change in the twinning of parishes the Wishaw/Motherwell area – St Patrick's and St Brendan's will share a Parish Priest: St Ignatius' and St Thomas' will share a Parish Priest. As a result of these changes, Fr Krzysztof will be moving to the parish of Holy Family, Mossend as Parish Priest. The Spiritans (the Holy Ghost Fathers) will take over the care of St Patrick's and St Brendan's; Fr Ricklan Mallya will be Parish Priest and Fr James Flynn as Assistant Priest. They will live in St Patrick's and continue as chaplains to Wishaw Hospital. Fr Kevin Lawrie will become the new Parish Priest of St Ignatius' and St Thomas'. Fr Christopher Morris will become Administrator of St Patrick's, Strathaven and continue as chaplain to Our Lady's High School.
